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1. Event Summary

The spring edition of the EUSA-NUSA online meeting took place on Tuesday, April 15, bringing together over 40 representatives from 23 countries. While the meeting served to update National University Sports Associations on general EUSA developments, a strong emphasis was placed on the DiscoverU project – Discovering University Sport and Supporting Dual Careers, co-funded by the European Union.

Following a welcome from EUSA President Adam Roczek, participants received updates from the EUSA Office on key events and activities, including the upcoming EUSA General Assemblies, recent project initiatives, and the evolving European Universities Championships programme.

A major part of the meeting focused on innovative approaches to increasing student participation in sport, aligned with DiscoverU's goals of supporting dual careers and enhancing access to diverse sport and educational opportunities.

EUSA Sports Coordinator Eszter Gulyas introduced several additions to the European Universities Championships programme—Winter Sports, Padel, and Power Lifting—which are also promoted through DiscoverU's outreach and engagement focus. These sports aim to attract new audiences and increase diversity across Europe's university sport landscape.

Andrej Pisl, EUSA Director of Projects and Policy, showcased further DiscoverU-related initiatives that promote health-enhancing physical activity and broad student involvement. One highlight was the Runners4All – European Students Run, which will be held in October 2025 in Ljubljana as part of the Ljubljana Marathon, offering opportunities for large-scale student participation. Other DiscoverU project partners also shared concrete examples of how the project is being implemented at local and national levels.

Croatian Academic Sport Federation (CASF/HASS) introduced new sports activities and the UniSport Health programme, integrating physical activity and education into student life.

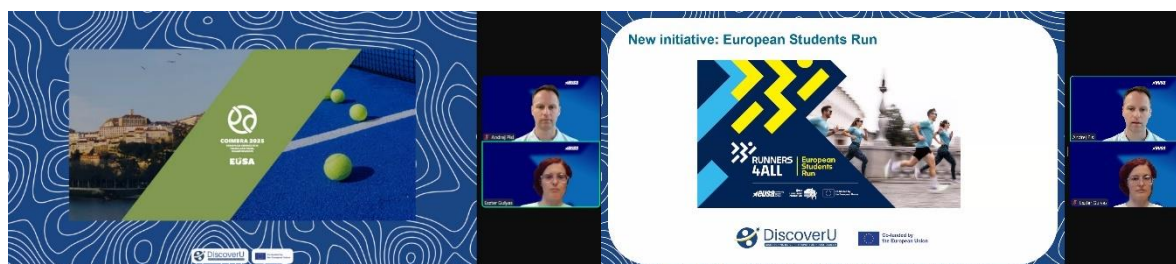
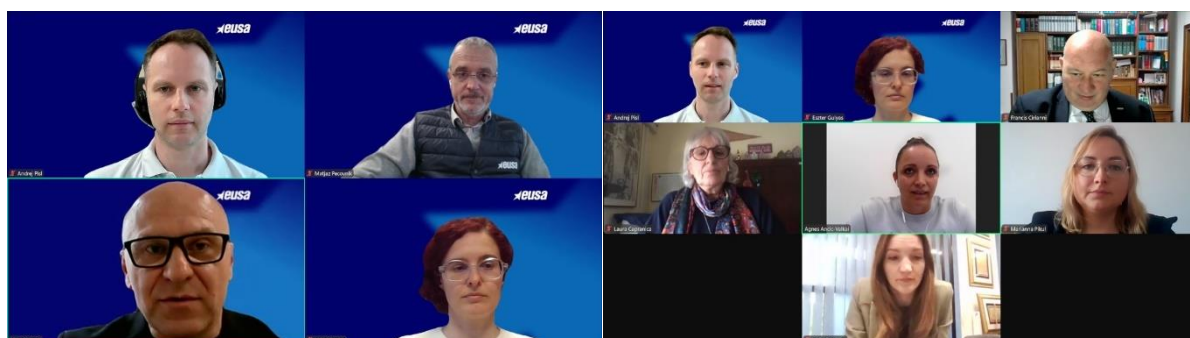
University Sports Association of Poland (AZS) presented updates on university championships and grassroots events, with an expanded sport offer developed through DiscoverU support.

Hungarian University Sports Federation (HUSF/MEFS) outlined the new format of the MEFOB Festival, a multisport event combining competitive and recreational elements, aligned with DiscoverU's mission.

University of Salerno (UNISA) and CUS Salerno shared the Erasmus Day initiative, designed to promote inclusion, cooperation, and intercultural exchange through sport—reflecting the values of DiscoverU and building momentum toward the European Universities Games 2026.

European Athlete as Student (EAS) network, presented by Laura Capranica, highlighted its efforts to support dual career development through awareness campaigns, stakeholder dialogue, and online engagement, including the popular EAS Cafés and the annual EAS Conference.

The next in-person meeting of DiscoverU partners will take place in October 2025, during the Ljubljana Marathon and European Students Run, accompanied by a dedicated project conference. These events will serve as key platforms to share results, engage stakeholders, and promote university sport and dual career support across Europe.



2. Event Promotion

The webinar was targeting mainly the partners and their networks, to exchange ideas and experiences. The main promotion was done by the project coordinator – the EUSA Institute.

The promotion was done in electronic and online form, with the focus on using internal news, emails and special announcements.

3. Event Participation

While 50 participants registered for the event, 35 unique participants attended the online event in real time, not including the 8 speakers and 1 administrator. Altogether, 44 persons took part in the webinar on April 15.

Participants came from 22 countries: Armenia, Albania, Austria, Croatia, Czechia, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Hungary, Israel, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Spain and Switzerland.

The webinar lasted for 95 minutes, and the average time attending was 80 minutes.

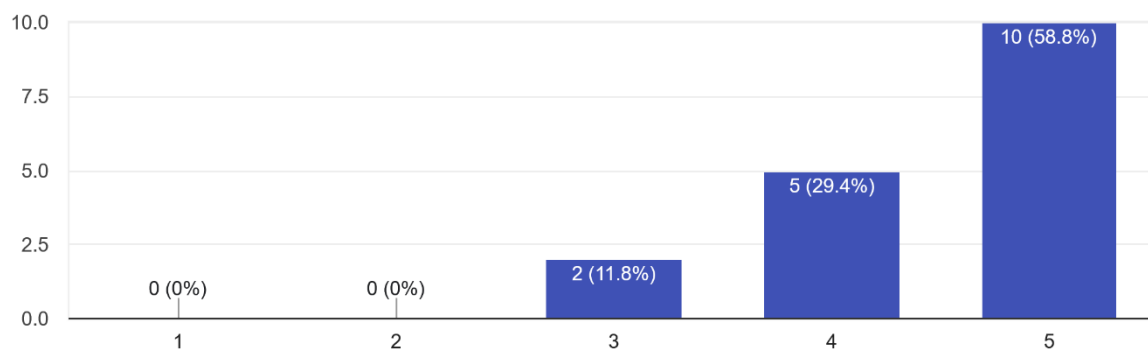

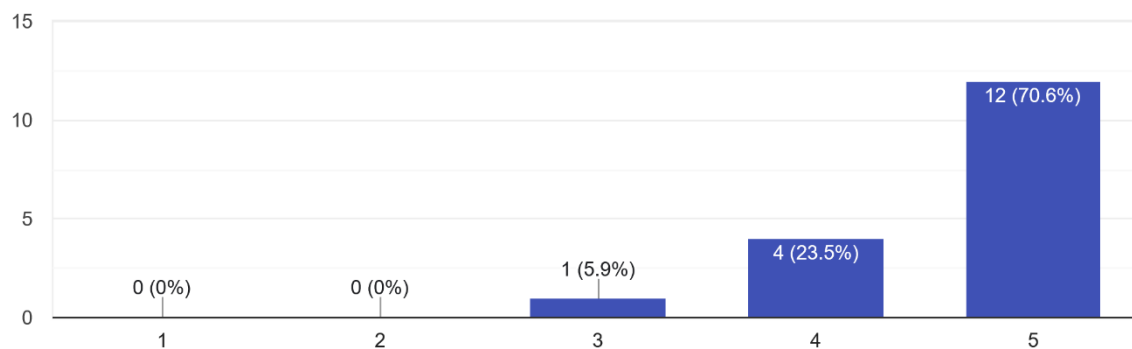

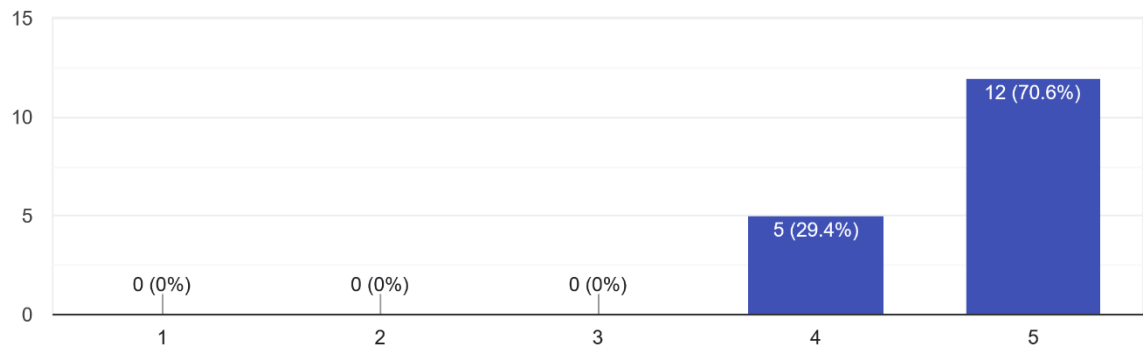

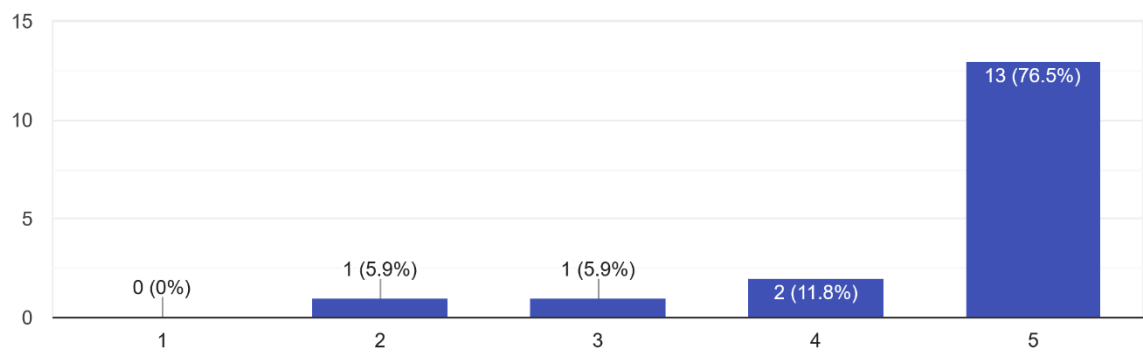

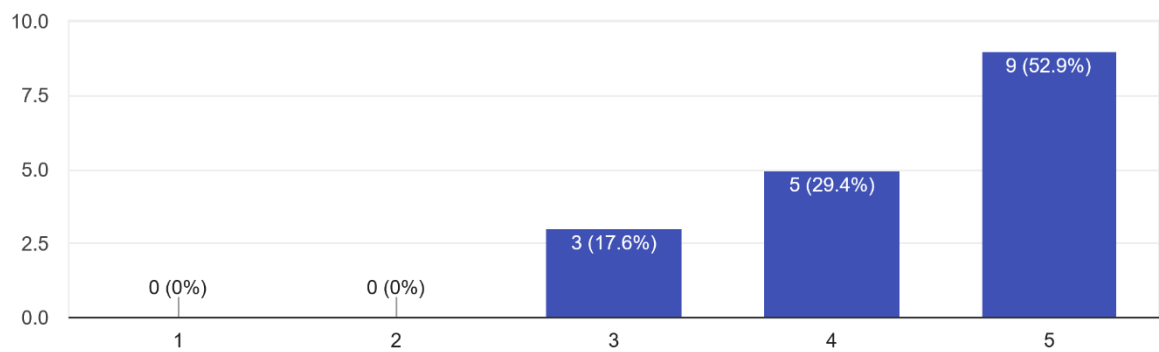

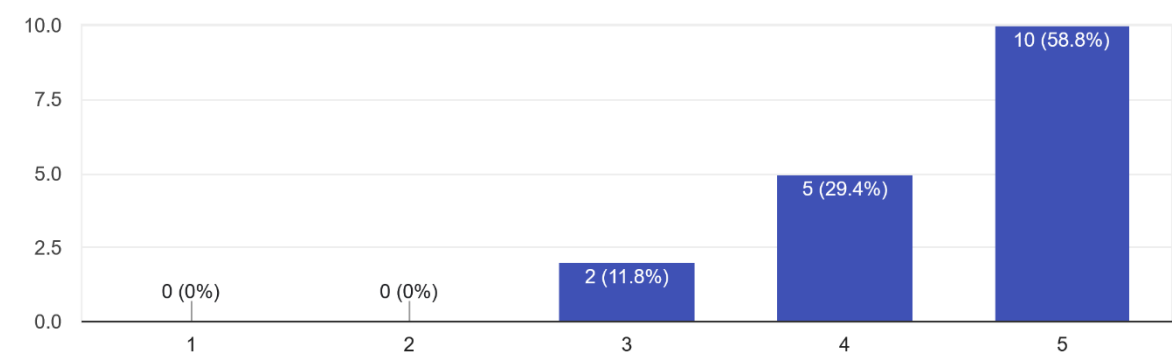

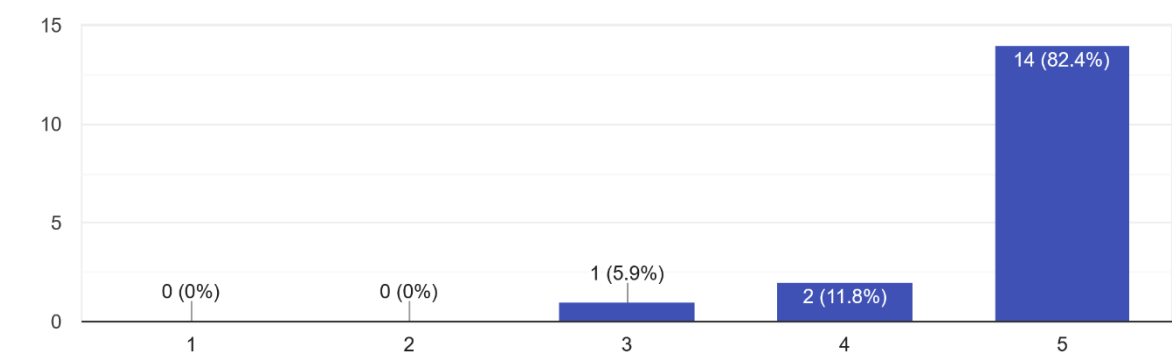

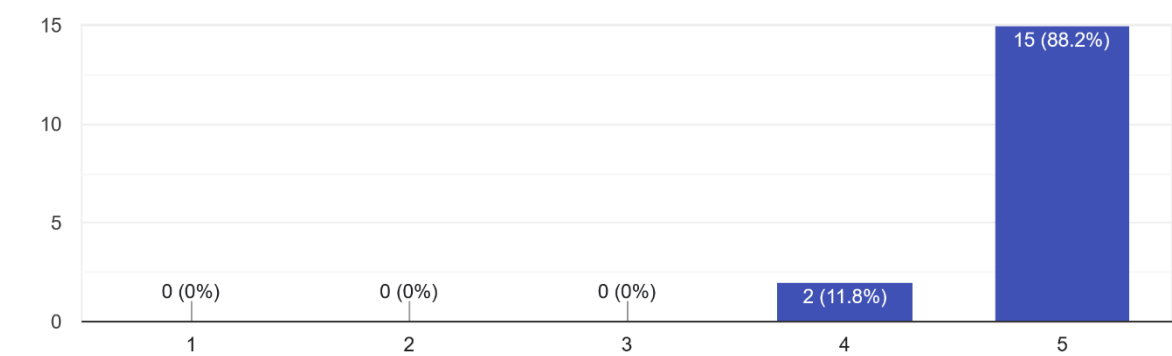

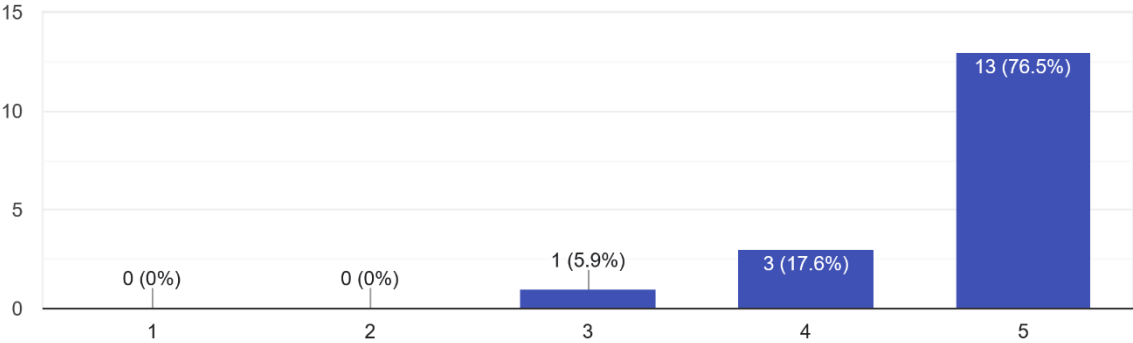

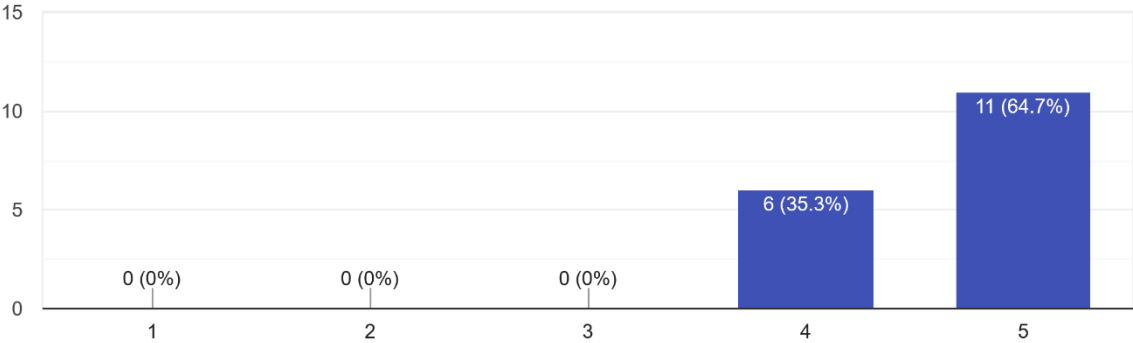

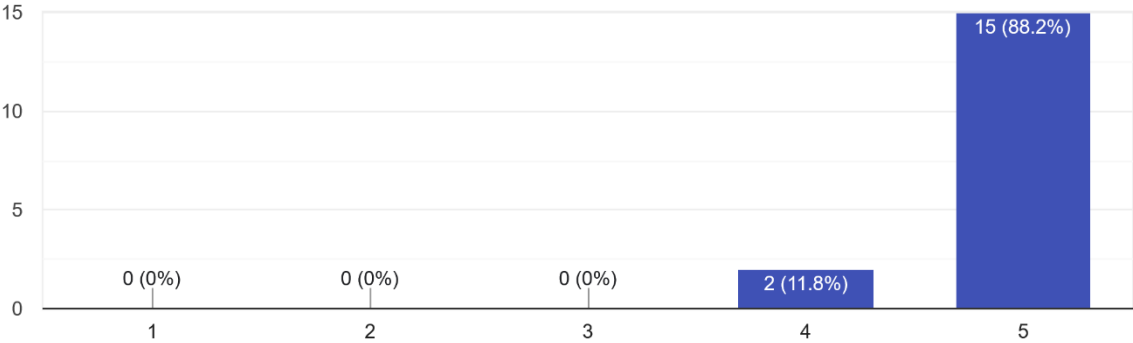

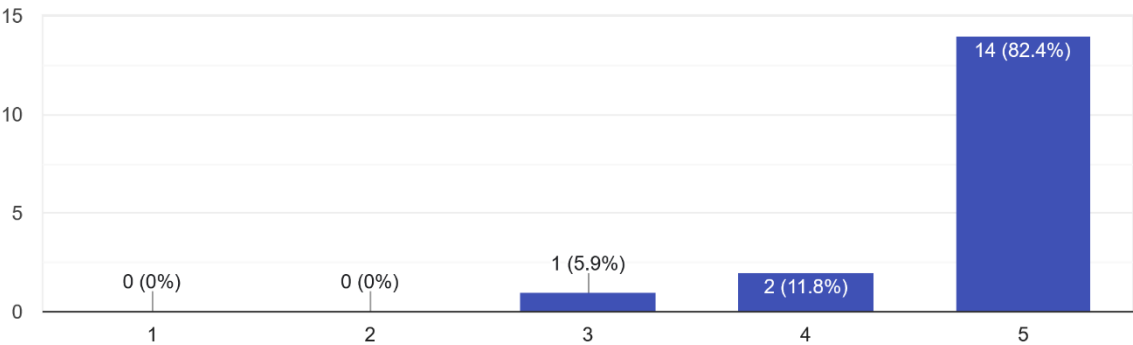

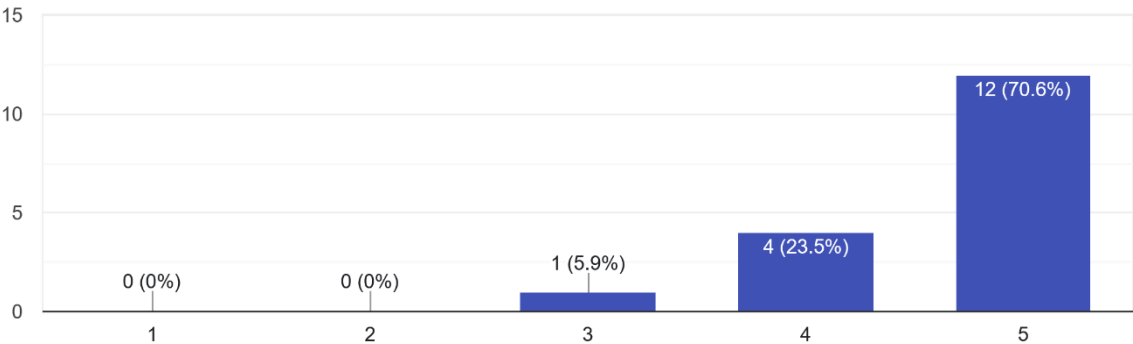

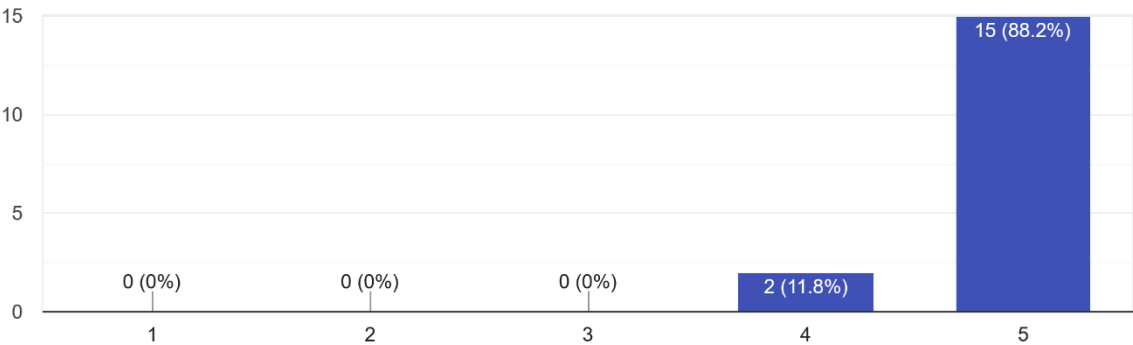

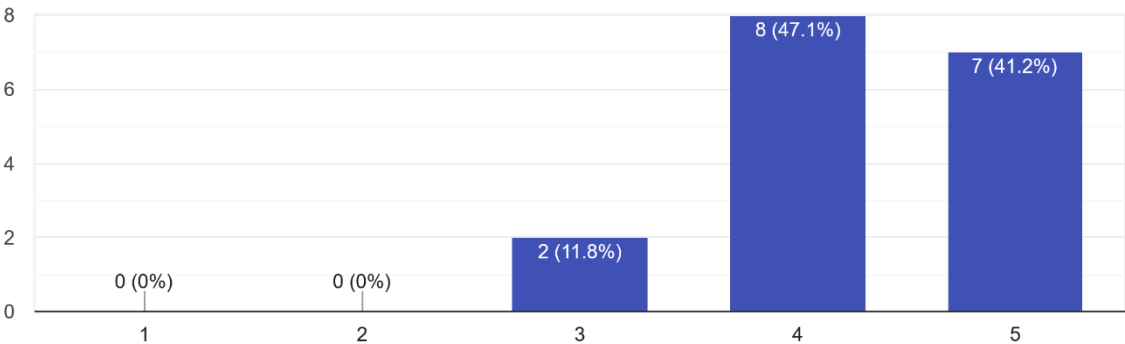

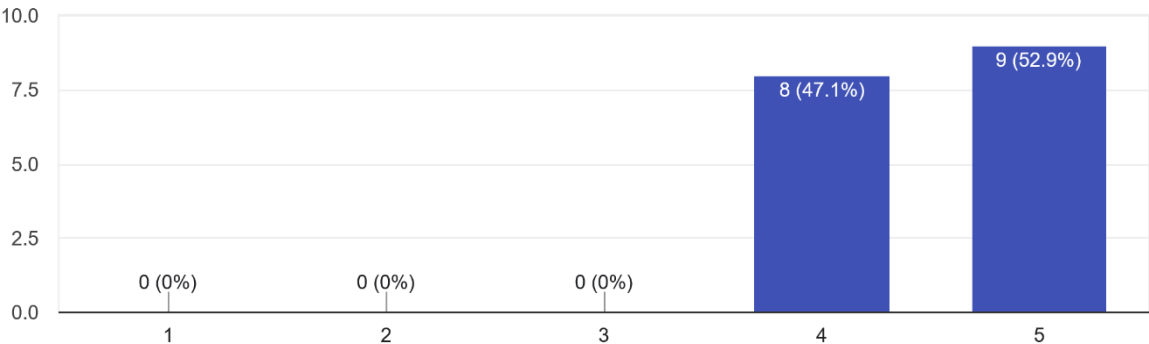

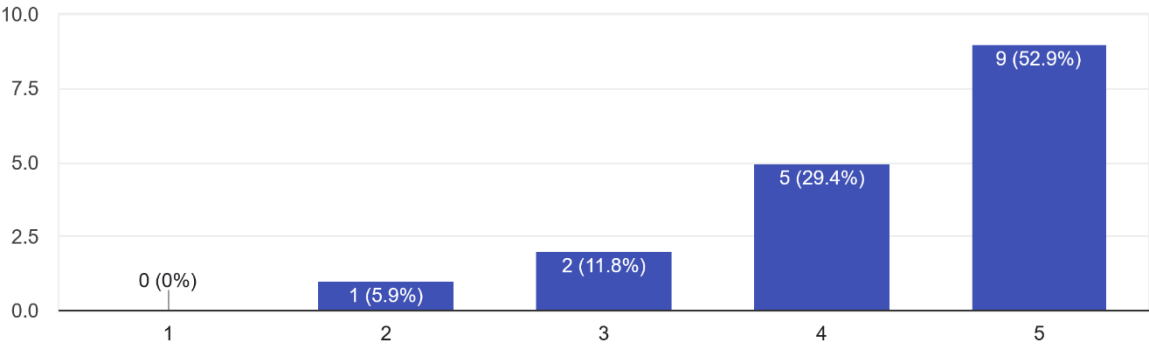

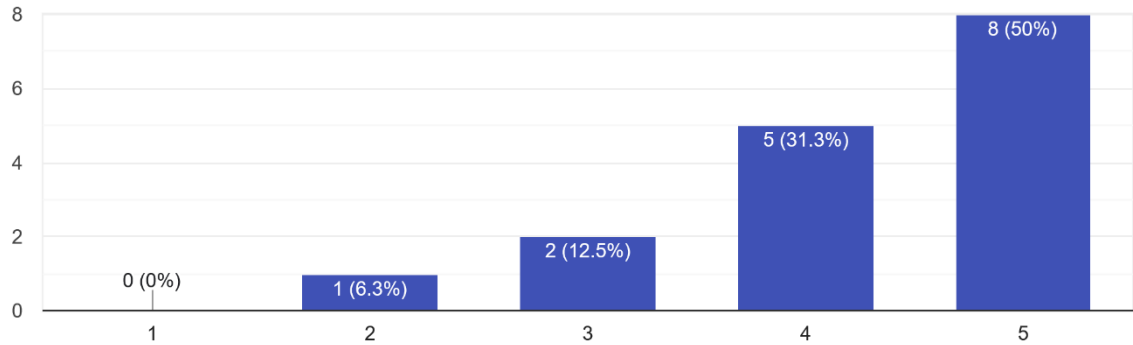

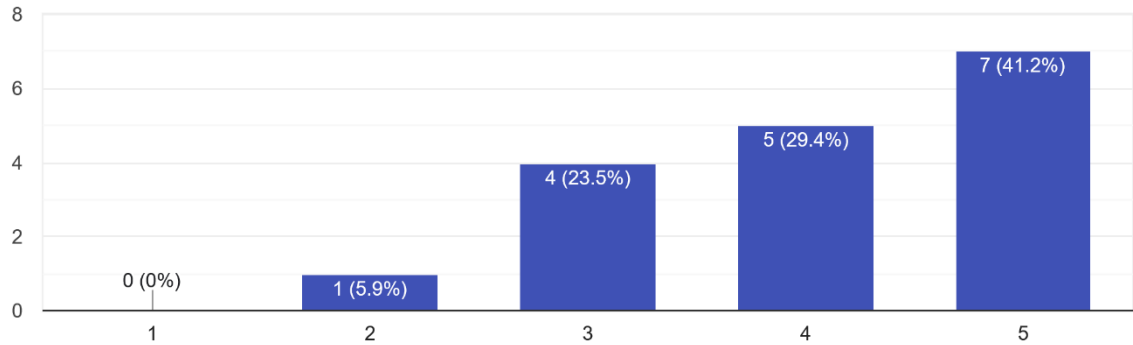

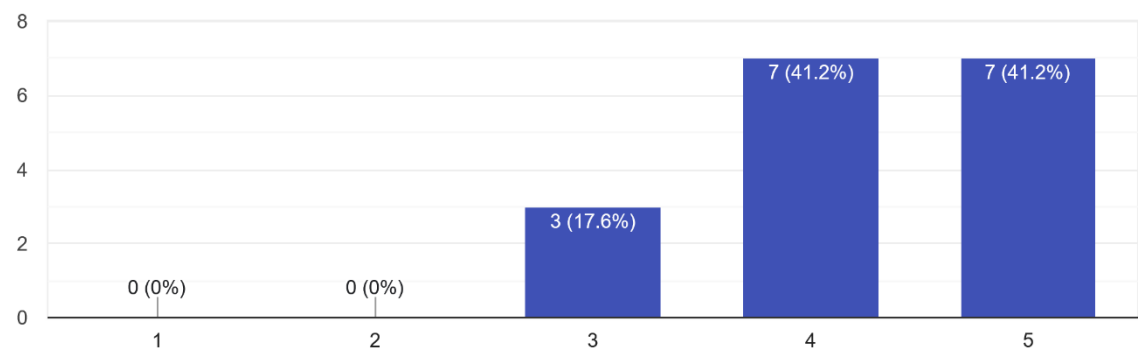

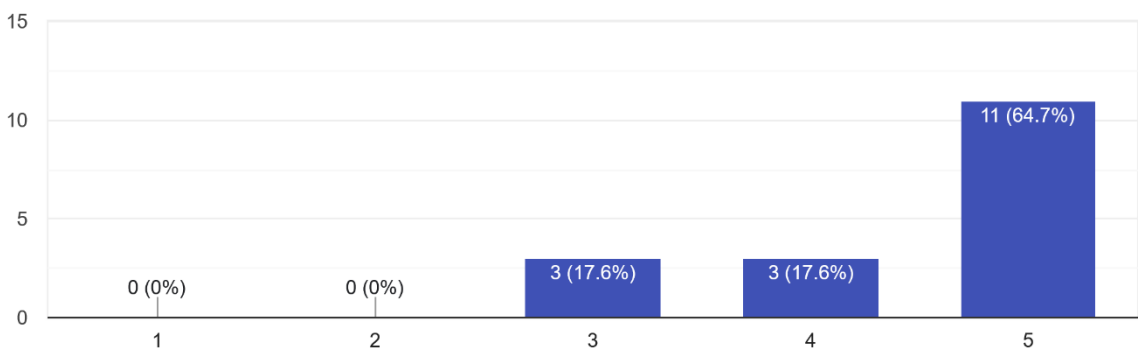

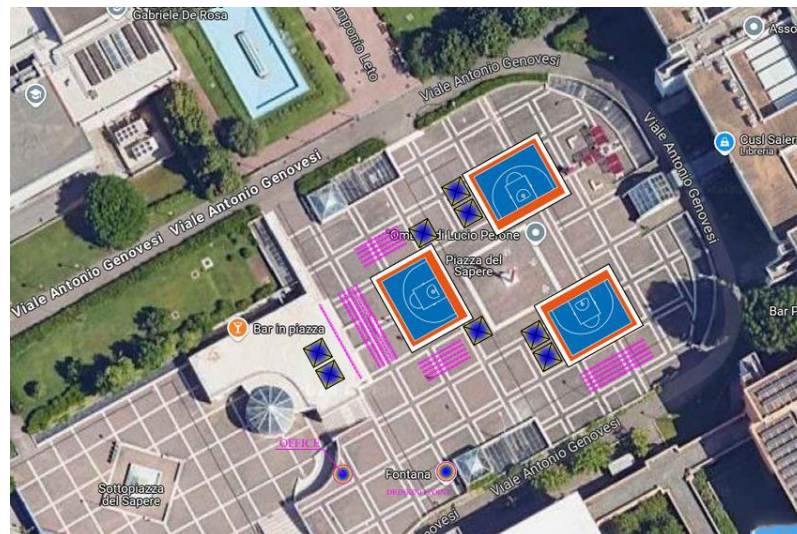
During the event, a meeting was held with the athletes of the Italian National Paralympic Dance Team. Following, a technical performance by the athletes of the Paralympic team.

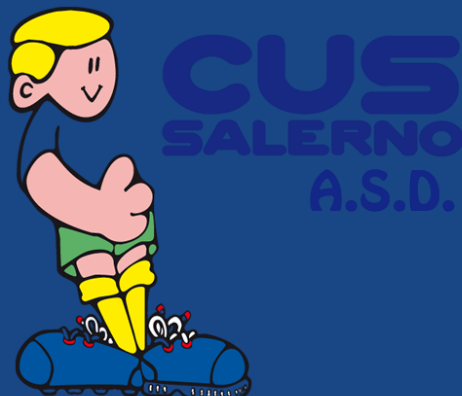


EUROPEAN UNIVERSITIES GAMES SALERNO 2026
